Note:-

1.The candidature for selection will be accepted on submission of valid DMC registration/applied for registration for PG within the stipulated period, subject to provision of passing out certificate.

2.Candidates already working in other organization/hospital are required to submit relieving order from concerned organization/hospital before joining. Without the relevant documents, no acceptance/joining to the post of Senior Resident will be allowed under any circumstances.

<u>Medical Examination:</u> The candidates are directed to produce a certificate of medical fitness from a qualified medical practitioner registered with the Delhi Medical Council.

3. <u>Tenure:(A)</u> Initial tenure for regular basis appointment is for one year, which can be extended on yearly basis maximum upto 03 years subject to satisfactory work and conduct report and willingness of the officer and availability of post in concerned department.

(B) Initial tenure for adhoc appointment is for 89 days, which can be extended as per residency scheme subject to satisfactory work and conduct report and willingness of the officer and availability of post in concerned

Department. The officer is required to apply for extension of tenure at least one month (15 days for adhoc appointment) before completion of his/her tenure. The total duration of senior residency cannot go beyond appointment) before completion of his/her tenure, including the duration of senior residency already three years (Ad-hoc + regular), in any circumstances, including the duration of senior residency already rendered by him in any govt./public sector undertaking hospital.

- 4. Pay & Allowances: (a) Rs.67700/- as per 7th CPC and other allowances.
- 5. House Rent Allowance: The entitlement of H.R.A will be as per Govt. Rules.
- 6. Past Experience: The period of service rendered by you as Senior Resident in Govt. Hospitals/autonomous Bodies founded by the Govt. prior to this appointment, if any, will count while reckoning the tenure as Senior Resident. An undertaking in this regard is to be furnished with acceptance letter along with documents proof.
- 7. <u>Private Practice</u>: The Private Practice of any kind what so ever is strictly prohibited. Besides the candidates will not work simultaneously as SR in any other hospital. Breach of this condition will result in termination of appointment & necessary proceedings may also be initiated in consultation with DMC for cancellation of certificate of Registration.
- 8. <u>Registration</u>: He/she must have valid registration certificate issued by Delhi Medical Council or should have applied for DMC on or before the date of joining.
- 9. <u>Uniform:</u> He/she will have to wear white coat on duty with the name badge. He/she will not smoke on duty or examining patients.
- 10. <u>Categories:</u> a) For SC/ST/OBC categories: The appointment is provisional and is subject to the verification of the caste /tribe/other backward class certificate through proper channel and if the claim to belong SC/ST/OBC is found false, the services will be terminated forthwithwithout prejudice to such further action that may be taken under the Indian Penal Code for production of false certificates. (b) For SC candidates: Candidates should inform about the change, if any of their religion to the department immediately.
- 11. Residency Scheme: He/she will work under residency scheme applicable to him/her from time to time.
- **12.** (A) <u>Leave Entitlement (For regular candidates):</u>. As per CCS (Leave) Rules, 1972. No salary will paid for any kind of unauthorized absence from duty even by the name of strike.
- (B) Leave Entitlement (For adhoc candidates):. For the present, he shall be entitled for a maximum of 2½ days Leave for each completed calendar month of service with prior approval of the Head of Department. No other leave of any nomenclature or vacation etc. will be admissible. However, in special circumstances, leave without pay can be granted solely on the discretion of the Head of Department keeping in view the public interest.
- 13. The appointment will be further subject to: (a) The production of certificates of medical fitness from the registered medical practitioner within 7 days of joining. (b) Submission of attested copies of all the certificates, candidates will be required to take an oath of allegiance to constitution of India on the prescribed Performa.
- 14.Other condition of service will be governed by relevant rules and orders from time to time: If any declaration given or information furnished by him/her found to be false or if he/she is found to have willfully suppressed any material, facts/information he/she is liable to be removed from services and such other action as Govt. may deem necessary.

- 15. Resignation/Termination: The appointment for the above mentioned post(s) on tenure basis, officials are required to give one month (15 days for adhoc appointment) prior notice for resignation otherwise are required to deposit one month salary(15 days for adhoc appointment) in lieu of the prior notice. In case, appointee is not interested in further extension, he/she is required to intimate the same before one month of completion of tenure(15 days for adhoc appointment) otherwise required to deposit one month (15 days for adhoc appointment)salary in lieu of the prior notice. In case of unsatisfactory work and conduct report from the concerned department, the appointment shall be terminated and no Correspondence shall be entertained in this regard. If termination of services is made due to continue absence of the appointee, on disciplinary grounds due to continuous absence of the appointee, the last day of working may be treated as starting day of continuous absence & one month salary will be deducted from last dues.
- 16. All the Selected candidates shall have to attend a compulsory training on BIO-MEDICAL WASTE MANAGEMENT. For venue and schedule of the programme, must contact I/C BIO-MEDICAL WASTE MANAGEMENT), Head of Lab Medicine, DSCI.
- 17. The senior Residents working in any specialty/Department may be required to perform duties in Accident & Emergency Department as per requirements of patient care.
- 18. The candidates who are seeking appointment on the basis of reservation to OBC'S must ensure that he/she possesses the caste/community certificate and does not fall in creamy layer and should submit a copy of non-

creamy layer certificate of the current financial year.

19. All candidates will be required to register themselves for 'Facial Recognition Attendance System (FRAS)' for marking attendance. Candidates are required to submit the prescribed proforma for the same to IT section of the Institute.

He/she is required to report for joining within (<u>07 days (before 12:00 noon)</u> from the date of issue of this letterto Recruitment Cell, 2nd Floor, Administrative Block with following documents, failing which offer will stand cancelled/withdrawn suomoto considering that the candidate is not interested. No claim or request for extension of period in joining will be entertained beyond this period.
